EVENT SPECIFIC CONDITIONS:

- Please be aware that the event does not take place at the exact location of the camping.** This is a short journey (250 yards) from the camping field to the leisure park where engines are ‘free to roam’ within reason. *Please be aware that no vehicle other than steam engines are allowed past the camping ground into the leisure park.* **Any other vehicles associated with an exhibit are to be left up in the camping field.**
- Coal will be issued at ONE BAG PER EXHIBIT.**
- Exhibits are encouraged to be ‘on site’ (in the public areas of the leisure park) as much as practicable during the events opening times (10.00am-4.30pm).
- Each exhibit has an entitlement to 4 ‘exhibitor passes’ to the event. These exhibitor passes allow the named pass holders to be ‘behind the scenes’ and at the camping area. Any unnamed additional passengers are deemed to be members of the public and are not allowed in any ‘staff only’ areas / camping area. Any persons found in these areas without a valid pass will be asked to leave. Exhibitor passes allow for unlimited train travel on all three railways throughout the event for the days that they are attending the event only.
- The main site opening times are between 09.30 – 4.30. Any access to the leisure park outside of these times is restricted.
- SUPERVISION OF EXHIBITS - Persons under 16 years of age are not permitted to drive or to be left in charge of mechanically propelled vehicles in the public areas under any circumstances and passengers may only be carried where properly constructed seats are fitted.**
- DATA PROTECTION** - Lappa Valley Railway Company Limited will hold your data solely for the purpose of contacting you in respect of your present and future attendance at the show. LVRCL will not share your data with any third party or contact you other than in reference to the event (unless ticked above).
- INSURANCE** - I declare that during the whole of the event period my entry will be covered by a Public Liability Policy including “Rally use” having a limit of indemnity of no less than £2,000,000 in respect of any one accident. I further declare that the use of the vehicle hereby entered is covered by insurance as required by the motor vehicles (Off Road Events) Regulations 1992, which is valid for such part of this event as shall take place on roads as defined in the Act. I confirm that the driver/s of any vehicle entered holds and is not disqualified from holding or obtaining a licence to drive a vehicle of the appropriate class.
- STEAM SPECIFIC** - My exhibit is covered by a public liability policy (as above) & by a boiler explosion policy. Both policies have a limit of indemnity of not less than £2,000,000 for any one accident: and cover for sparks and ashes not less £100,000. The boiler of any steam plant I enter, carries a current boiler inspection certificate and I will produce documentary evidence of such insurance & inspection before participating in the event. Where applicable drivers have read the National Traction Engine Trust (NTET) Traction Engine code of practice and I agree to abide by the code of practice.
